We conduct Joy of Giving, Daan Utsav drive where anyone can donate anything at the school counters which can be used by underprivileged children and families. This donation goes for charity. In the co-curricular activities, our students have participated in a number of activities and events in session 2019-2020. Our children participated and won many prizes at a number of events at a number of schools like Aster Public school, Pragyan School, JayPee Public school Noida, Yadu Public school Noida, Hillwood Academy, Scholar's Home, DLF World School, JBM Global School Noida, Greater Noida Stadium, Cornerstone India, Jaypee Public school Greater Noida. Like every session, this year too we conducted a Health check up for all the students by experienced and specialist Doctors and dentists.

We celebrated all Indian festivals along with few international festivals and important days in our school along with the regular studies.

We also had an international Environment seminar at our school on 17th December 2018 where two foreign delegates- Miss Teen Venezuela, Kiara Pineda and Miss Teen Belgium, Miss Lola Paquay spent the whole day with our students. Students really enjoyed their company and got an international exposure while Miss Belgium and Miss Venezuela have taken back wonderful memories from India of the hospitality of Grads.
